


Books for Free. Read for Fun.

How does Open eBooks work?

A teacher, librarian, or program leader confirms that students qualify for the program. They register to generate credentials for students. Students receive their credentials from these trusted educators, and use them to access Open eBooks. Students can access Open eBooks on a web browser, or download the app on iOS or Android.
